Location :

UAA, based in Ganjam district of Orissa since 1966, is headquartered at Ganjam town, at a distance of 140 Km, towards south from Bhubaneswar, the state capital,

Legal Status :

United Artists' Association is a voluntary organisation, registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860, in 1967, It is registered with the Ministry of Home Affairs. to receive foreign contribution.

History:

In 1965 different youth groups in Ganiam town united together to work under a single umbrella and raised funds through cultural programmes & drama to be used for welfare and emergency relief and establishment of educational institutions Thus, the organisation derived its name - "UNITED ARTISTS' ASSOCIATION".

Up to the year 1977 UAA worked exclusively with its own funds. In 1978,the first government funded Balwadi and Creche programme was taken up. During the next decade UAA stepped up its involvement in the rural areas, with the objective of enabling a process of development for the disadvantaged sections of society.

Changing Role: In the year 1995 Govt, of Orissa and Unicef recognized the organisation as nodal NGO and canalized their funds through UAA to develop water and sanitation status in the rural areas of the district. Since then the organisation works with a network of grassroots NGO/ CBOs and played a catalytic role to develop the capacity in terms of managerial, technical and HR of its network members. Currently UAA provides support service to:

- 22-Block level NGOs. 2 Block level dalit women's organisations, 1 District level federation of farmers organisations.
- 1 District level federation of tribal organisation.
- 1 State level federation of women marine fish workers' organisations and traditional fish workers' union

Program :
